



## DRIVING DIRECTIONS



### From points North & East (WILMINGTON, I-40, MYRTLE BEACH, ETC...)

Take I-40 East into Wilmington and head South on Highway 17 into downtown Wilmington. Continue south on 17, through N. Myrtle Beach, Myrtle Beach, and Pawleys Island. As you enter the town of Georgetown, you will take a right and head north on Highway 701 for a few miles. Mansfield Road will be on your right, directly off of 701. The drive is approximately 110 miles from Wilmington, N.C. or 45 miles from Myrtle Beach, S.C.

### From points South & West (CHARLESTON, I-26, COLUMBIA, ETC...)

Take I-26 East towards Charleston and exit North/East on I-526 towards Mount Pleasant. I-526 will dead end into Highway 17. Take a left on 17 and head north until you reach the town of Georgetown. At the intersection of 17 and 701, turn onto 701 and head north for a few miles. Mansfield Road will be on your right, directly off of 701. The drive is approximately 60 miles from Charleston, S.C.

\* There are numerous short-cuts that will decrease the distance to Mansfield, but these roads are not as well marked and can become confusing at times. Highway 17 is by far the easiest route into Mansfield Plantation, but it is not the only way. A detailed map is recommended for any alternate routes.

\*\* Please note that I-526 and Highway 17 can become very congested in Mount Pleasant, S.C. during peak seasons and on the weekends. Plan accordingly, or take an alternate route such as ALT 17. A detailed map is recommended for any alternate routes to Mansfield Plantation
